




Network Utility

Using Network Utility for Mac OS X

Locate and open the **Macintosh HD** from the Desktop.



Locate and open the **Applications** icon located on the window below the menu bar.



Locate and double-click the **Utilities Folder**.


Locate and open **Network Utility**.



Choose the Appropriate Network Adaptor from the drop-down menu.


Ethernet Interface 0 = Ethernet/NIC Connection

Ethernet Interface 1 = Apple Airport Wireless Card




Ping

Choose the **Ping** tab if you wish to perform a Ping test.
Enter a network address to ping in the field provided (IP or URL).




Highlight the Ping results.
Under the **Edit** menu choose **COPY** to copy results to clipboard.
Paste results to a new E-mail message and send to ISP.



Trace Route

Choose the **Traceroute** tab if you wish to perform a trace route test.
Enter a network address (IP or URL) to perform the trace route.



Highlight the trace route results.
Under the **Edit** menu choose **COPY** to copy results to clipboard.
Paste results to a new E-mail message and send to ISP.
